

Terms and conditions for the Waving *not* drowning Draw

1. The Name of the Society is Working Families.
2. The current person responsible is Sarah Jackson, Working Families, 1-3 Berry Street, London EC1V 0AA.
3. Participation in the Waving *not* drowning Draw costs £2 per entry per month.
4. The draw is made on the last Friday of each calendar month.
5. A six digit number will be allocated by the promoter to each entry.
6. The six digit number allocated to an entry will remain the same for the period of a player's participation in the Waving *not* drowning Draw.
7. There are no restrictions to the number of entries one person can make.
8. Players must be aged 16 or over to participate in the Waving *not* drowning Draw.
9. 33% of the profits of the Waving *not* drowning Draw will be paid out in prize money (prize fund).
10. 67% of the profits of the Waving *not* drowning Draw will go to Working Families.
11. Participants may be contacted by Working Families for other campaigning purposes.
12. Working Families will confirm proof of receipt of entry by letter. If confirmation has not been received within 28 days of posting [applying] please contact Working Families at the address below, by telephone on 020 7253 7243, or by email at office@workingfamilies.org.uk.
13. Payment for participation in the Waving *not* drowning Draw can be made by direct debit through banks and building societies which operate in Great Britain.
14. Waving *not* drowning Draw numbers will be entered into the draw within one month of payment being cleared.
15. The player must hold a bank account or building society account from mainland Great Britain out of which payment for the subscription shall be made, (this excludes Northern Ireland, Isle of Man and the Channel Island accounts).
16. Players can apply by sending a completed form with payment authority to Working Families, 1-3 Berry Street, London EC1V 0AA or by telephone 020 7253 7243. Cancellation of a direct debit is a player's responsibility and any monies paid in advance are not refundable. Working Families would be grateful if you would notify the office in writing of your intention to withdraw from this scheme.
17. A subscription for a rolling term shall continue until terminated by the player, by giving of at least four weeks' notice in writing of a player's intention to withdraw from this scheme.
18. The player will be required to supply certain information to Working Families during the subscription application process which will assist Working Families (i) in determining whether or not the player meets the criteria set out above and (ii) to verify the player's eligibility to play the Waving *not* drowning Draw. This information may include but will not be limited to the player's name, address details, telephone numbers, date of birth, email address and bank details. Working Families reserves the right to request an authentication agency to verify such information relating to the player. If Working Families is not satisfied that the information provided (i) is adequate and/or (ii) has been verified by Working Families or any authentication agency, then Working Families may refuse an application for a subscription at its absolute discretion.
19. A player's number selection(s) contained in a subscription will not be entered into a draw and the player shall not be entitled to any prize for that draw in respect of such selection(s) where the player's payment has not been received by Working Families at least 48 hours before the relevant draw.
20. A subscription or part thereof shall be void and shall not in any case entitle its holder to a prize if:
 - Working Families has not received the payment required by it for that subscription or the relevant part of the subscription by 48 hours before the date on which the subscription or the relevant part of the subscription would have, but for such non-payment, become a subscription or relevant part of the subscription containing numbers which match the winning numbers;
 - or

- The direct debit payment fails without Working Families receiving by 48 hours before the date on which the subscription or relevant part of the subscription would have, but for such non-payment, become a subscription or relevant part of the subscription containing numbers which match the winning numbers, an amount (by another payment method) equivalent to the amount which Working Families did not collect by reason of such failure.

21. Working Families reserves the right to withhold payment of any prize or to cancel or suspend a player's subscription if, prior to commencement of his/her subscription, the player did not meet the relevant criteria of 5, 10, 12 above.

22. A subscription shall commence on the date of the first draw recorded after the subscription confirmation.

23. Working Families at its absolute discretion and without specifying any reason, may cancel a subscription or may partially cancel a subscription by removing one or more plays from the subscription, with effect from the next draw(s) of the Waving *not* drowning Draw to which that subscription relates, and:

- in the event of a cancellation of a subscription as a whole Working Families' only liability to the player shall be to repay to the player any monies previously paid in respect of that subscription for any draw or draws of the Waving *not* drowning Draw to which the subscription relates occurring after such cancellation and to pay to the player any unpaid prizes due to him/her in respect of draws prior to such cancellation; or

- in the event of a partial cancellation of a subscription, Working Families' only liability to the player shall be to repay to the player any monies previously paid which are attributable to the draw(s) of the game(s) which has/have been removed from the subscription but only in respect of the draw(s) occurring after such partial cancellation and to pay to the player any unpaid prizes due to him/her in respect of draws of the game(s) which has/have been removed from the subscription prior to such cancellation.

24. The promoter accepts no responsibility if a direct debit is cancelled in error.

25. No responsibility is taken for application forms lost, delayed or damaged in the post and proof of posting will not be accepted as proof of receipt.

26. The Waving *not* drowning draw takes place on the first Wednesday of every calendar month. Six numbers will be drawn randomly. The first number drawn will be allocated the jackpot prize of up to £200, the next 5 numbers will win £10 each. Working Families will, from time to time, vary this in accordance with point 9.

27. The Waving *not* drowning Draw number supplied by Working Families is not proof of entry into the draw, nor ownership of the draw numbers.

28. The result of each draw is final. No correspondence will be entered into.

29. Winners will be notified by post. Players are responsible for notifying Working Families of any change of address. A cheque will be sent out within 28 working days of the draw to the name and address of the registered owner of each winning number and should be cashed within 180 days of issue.

30. A list of winners will appear on the Working Families website at www.workingfamilies.org.uk or is available by phoning Working Families to have them emailed to you.

31. The promoter reserves the right to delay the draw if it falls on a public holiday or the registered office is closed. The draw will take place on the next Working Families working day.

32. For a list of past winners send a SAE to the address below specifying which month's results are desired.

33. Working Families reserves the right to stop the Waving *not* drowning Draw by giving one month's written notice to all registered players.

34. Working Families is registered with the London Borough of Islington under the Lotteries and the Law (Gambling Act 2005). Official Promoter: Working Families, 1-3 Berry Street, London EC1V 0AA.

35. The Waving *not* drowning Draw is open to all mainland Great Britain residents (this excludes Northern Ireland, Isle of Man and Channel Islands.)
